I. Don't Get Catfished.

Catfished

having a **relationship** of any **sort** with someone on social media that isn't who they say they are, by using someone else pictures or living a **totally** different lifestyle than what they told you.

II. Have a blueprint of the plan.

A. Abraham, a father.

Genesis 12:1-3 (NIV) *The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you.² "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.*

B. Isaac, a son. (Genesis 22:1-4)

Genesis 22:1-4 (NLT) *Sometime later, God tested Abraham's faith. "Abraham!" God called. "Yes," he replied. "Here I am."*
