Proverbs 14:30 (NIV) *A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.*

I. The problem with envy.

Look Up Text: Esther 5:10-13 (NIV)

A. Envy rots relationships.

James 3:16 (AMP) *For wherever there is jealousy (envy) and contention (rivalry and selfish ambition), there will also be confusion (unrest, disharmony, rebellion) and all sorts of evil and vile practices.*

B. Envy spoils our life.

Genesis 30:1 (NIV) *When Rachel saw that she was not bearing Jacob any children, she became jealous of her sister. So she said to Jacob, "Give me children, or I'll die!"*

II. Two creepy friends of envy.

A. Comparison.

1 Samuel 18:8-9 (NLT) *This made Saul very angry. "What's this?" he said. "They credit David with ten thousands and me with only thousands. Next they'll be making him their king!"⁹ So from that time on Saul kept a jealous eye on David.*

B. Complaining.

Philippians 2:14 (TLB) *In everything you do, stay away from complaining...*

III. Purge envy with contentment.

Philippians 4:11-13 (NIV) *...I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. ¹² I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. ¹³ I can do everything through him who gives me strength.*

Philippians 4:8 (NIV) *Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.*

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
