Isaiah 1:18 (TEV) *The LORD says, “Now, let’s settle the matter. You are stained red with sin, but I will wash you as clean as snow. Although your {sin} stains are deep red, you will be as white as wool.”*

I. The Goofy Guy. (John 1:26-27)

Mark 1:5 (NIV) *The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.*

Matthew 3:4 (AMP) *John’s garments were made of camel’s hair, and he wore a leather girdle about his waist; and his food was locusts and wild honey.*

II. Look...!!

John 1:29 (NLT2) *The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!*

III. The Lamb.

Exsanguination: To bleed out, to die from loss of blood.

IV. Forgive Self or Forgiven? (Micah 7:18-19)

Colossians 2:13-14 (NCV) *When you were spiritually dead because of your sins and because you were not free from the power of your sinful self, God made you alive with Christ, and he forgave all our sins. ¹⁴ He canceled the debt, which listed all the rules we failed to follow. He took away that record with its rules and nailed it to the cross.*
