I. Shechem: Shoulder.

II. Hashkem: Persistent.

Jeremiah 12:5 (MSG) *So, Jeremiah, if you are worn out in this footrace with people, what makes you think you can race against horses? And if you can't keep your wits during times of calm, what's going to happen when real troubles break loose...?*

III. Early Sunshine.

Psalms 108:1-3 (MSG) *I'm ready, God, so ready, ready from head to toe. Ready to sing, ready to raise a God-song: ² "Wake, soul! Wake, lute! Wake up, you sleepyhead sun!" ³ I'm thanking you, GOD, out in the streets, singing your praises in town and country.*

IV. New Sunshine. (Jeremiah 2:23-24)

Lamentations 3:22-24 (Para) *The faithful love of the LORD never ends! It can never run out. It's because of that love we are not destroyed. His mercies never cease. ²³ Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. They are a new daily creation, just as there is a new sunrise. ²⁴ I say to myself, "The LORD is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in him!"*

Luke 10:41-42 (CEV) *The Lord answered, "Martha, Martha! You are worried and upset about so many things, ⁴² but only one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen what is best, and it will not be taken away from her."*
