Run to Subway, grab food then eat here on the picnic table or go to one of the local parks, let the kids play while you visit.


Or bring dogs and buns, and use the church grill.

The Bible teaches that the Holy Spirit is willing to give gifts to edify, exhort and comfort the church until Jesus returns (1 Cor. 12). If you sense the Holy Spirit is speaking to you for the congregation, we desire those words to be heard in an orderly way (1 Cor. 14). If you receive a vocal prompting (tongues, prophecy, wisdom, knowledge, interpretation), we invite you to write it down or share with a pastor what the prompting is and one of the pastors will discern if and when the word needs to be spoken.
